**Mission:** Summer camp offers a wonderful opportunity for children to enjoy happy character-building summer days in the great outdoors near the lake and in the woods. Children will receive Ukrainian Orthodox Christian religious instruction, introduction to conversational Ukrainian and a fundamental knowledge of the Ukrainian culture. They will have the opportunity to swim, dance, do crafts, participate in sports and enjoy the fun hikes, campfires, cookouts and singing. All this is accomplished in an atmosphere of friendship, trust, kindness and fun.

\*\*Parents please help us by **NOT trying to register before 5 pm**. If you arrive early, feel free to spend the time exploring camp with your children. However, the dorms and office will not be open for registration until 5 pm. Bunks are assigned to each camper and a top or bottom bunk may be requested. We will do our best to accommodate special requests but there is no guarantee that you will receive what you requested. This will make registration day more efficient.

**There will be compulsory lice checks before registration and there is a NO Nit policy in place. If your child is found to have lice or nit, they will not be allowed to register or come to camp that week. Children will also be required to complete a COVID health assessment at registration and any child that develops a fever or shows COVID symptoms will be isolated and must be picked up immediately.**

## Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP) Consent Form

As a public camp, Camp Kiev's K Hi is required to act in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP), which sets out standards as to the collection, use and disclosure of personal activities. Campers may be photographed and videotaped for camp purpose. The camp cannot penalize individuals for refusing to give consent by denying them any benefit or service provided through the original collection.

We believe the uses listed below are part of a vital, healthy camp and participation of all campers is important and encouraged. The personal information collected will be used for the following purposes:

1. The taking of individual or group photos for camp purposes
2. The release of the children's names for recognition of birthdays, activities or involvement within the camp or Church.
3. Once parents or other members of the public are invited to camp events, the event becomes public and anyone in attendance may take photographs without first obtaining consent.
